Call to Order

In attendance: John Kaiser, Dick Juhnke, Kerry Fee, Mike Fanning, Tom Burns, Parks Frady, Bert Otis, Ernie McCrackin, Clint Tinsley, Emily Post.

Minutes : Review of Minutes for March 17, 2016 Meeting

Motion made by Ernie McCrackin to approve minutes, second by Mike Fanning, no discussion; all in favor. Motion carries.

Review/Decide on Landowner Refuse Assessment Requests

Old Business – Updates

Discussion on Landfill Closure

Parks Frady provided comments about current status of bid award and upcoming schedule. Parks discussed \$1.4 million budget.

John Kaiser stated the need to discuss buildings at landfill and future use. Discussion followed about use of buildings and values, speculated about value of buildings.

Parks stated that equipment is still there. County has a list of equipment there.

Discussion on ‘Gardiner’ Collection Site

Parks stated collection is going well with site. Community cleanup event will occur this weekend. The event is free for disposal. Parks stated it is one extra trip for county refuse. PC brings two roll offs and the community fills them up and local guys help manage the event to prevent abuse of the event.

Parks stated that there is a 20 yard roll off at the site that is pulled once every two weeks along with compactor.

Discussion on ‘Corwin Spings’ & ‘Carbella’ Collection Sites

Parks Frady stated walk-in gates only at these sites, 30 yard roll offs are there. Discussion followed about complaints from public about walk-in disposal at the sites. Need for ramp due to difficulty throwing bags

in roll off due to height. A Combination lock may be warranted, if considered truck width must be maintained with fences and roll offs.

Discussion on 'Forest Service' Collection Site

Parks stated this site is always busy, things going well.

Discussion on 'Fleshmen Creek' Collection Site

Parks stated no negative feedback. Site is very clean. Combo locks are working. No trash seen outside locked gates.

Discussion about city transfer station hours of operation.

Discussion on 'Nead' Collection Site

Parks discussed existing signage and discussion about need for professional signage followed. Need for tags checking at the site.

Discussion on 'Trail Creek' Collection Site

Discussion about whether combination locks would work at this site. Cameras are there but video needs to be looked at. Parks will feels it is too busy for combination locks.

Clint Tinsley provided statements about his opinion on using combination locks at Trail Creek site. Feels there are problems due to hours of city transfer station.

Parks stated that we've looked at video footage when violations occur. Pretty infrequent abuse.

Discussion on 'Chico' Collection Site

Estimate for fencing is approximately \$10,000 for regular 6' fence. Discussion about need for fencing for trash blowing, discontent of neighbors.

Parks received quotes for new boxes for Chico Hot Springs, it will be in county rotation for pickup.

Discussion/Decision on Recycling Contract

John Kaiser provided comments about need to pass this issue back to Parks. He'd like to form a subcommittee to work on it.

Parks Frady provided statements about contract status. County was previously paying \$10,000 for everything. Will charge \$10,000 for everything but cardboard and will add an additional \$24-28,000 for cardboard.

Discussion about cost to recycle.

Recycling subcommittee: Kerry Fee, John Kaiser, Mike Fanning.

John Kaiser proposed recommendation to pay \$5,000 for first half of FY16 and paying half of the \$26,000 for the second half of FY16.

Bert Otis proposed to pay him \$10,000 that has been standard and pay him half of the \$23,000 increase above costs.

Discussion on County Solid Waste Contract w/ City of Livingston

Clint Tinsley provided comments about current status of the city county contract for tipping fees for county trash.

John Kaiser proposed setting up a subcommittee for future discussion. Dick Juhnke, Tom Burns and Ernie McCrackin.

Parks will attend both subcommittee meetings.
