Mill Creek Road: Mile Post 0 to Mile Post 11.6

The Mill Creek Road Surface Preservation Project has reached its completion point!

This week the contractor completed applying the permanent pavement markings on the asphalt section of the project. The contractor placed STOP bars at the intersections of Highway 89 and 540 and also completed placing the bicycle symbols along the shoulder of the roadway.

With the placement of the pavement markings and addressing the other minor punch list items the work for the project is complete. There will be no further work or impact to public traffic after this week.

This will be the last newsletter for the project. On behalf of the Federal Highway Administration we would like to thank our Contractor, Riverside Contracting, Inc., and our partners, Park County and the United States Forest Service, for a successful completion to the project.
